


A sheet of 3 auction slips is enclosed. Copy it if you need more to save time upon arrival. More sheets will be available at the meeting.

Bring lots of items and friends with money.


There will be two checkout stations. One for checks which will be the faster line and one for cash which is usually slower because of change making and receipt writing.


Our May Board meeting will be held at the Museum in the Geology Dept. Office at 6:30 P.M. Members are welcome.
