Although he only has a booth at about three shows each year, Dave maintains a showroom in Denver to which interested persons may make an appointment to come view his fine specimens. Dave has been a consistent supporter of FM (and other local clubs) over the years, and has always been willing to donate good material to our silent auctions. Some of his specialties as a dealer include Mexican silver minerals, specimens from the Black Cloud mine, specimens from the Bill and Carol Smith collection, and Colorado minerals in general. However, Dave's personal collection is strongly focused on Colorado minerals, of which he has some superb pieces (for example, the only known example of Colorado milarite, from the Crystal Peak area), and this is what his talk and slide show about his collection will emphasize.
